Traditions are systems of knowledge, values, and practices passed across generations. They include philosophies, healing systems, cultural arts, and ways of living that embody the long-tested wisdom of civilisations.

Traditions preserve identity, continuity, and accumulated human experience and offer holistic insights into wellbeing, ethics, consciousness, health, and nature—complementing what modern science cannot fully explain.

Model for conference interaction and integration

The **Global S a T A Conference** is designed as an integrative and dynamic forum rather than a series of isolated sessions **breaking the silos**. Each day is anchored around **one principal theme**, providing a clear focal point while remaining actively interconnected with the other core domains of S a T A. The day opens with a **plenary session under a single thematic heading and chairmanship**, establishing shared context, key questions, and guiding frameworks. Participants then divide into **parallel interdisciplinary subsections**, where the theme is examined through scientific, traditional, clinical, cultural, technological, and societal lenses. Midway through the day, these groups reconvene to **exchange insights and synthesise common threads**, ensuring cross-disciplinary integration. The day concludes with a **full collective assembly**, during which emerging issues, convergent ideas, and shared priorities are discussed. This final session includes the **assessment of all submitted papers and the formulation of concluding statements**, which inform the **policy frameworks under each thematic heading**.

All accepted papers, together with the **Conference conclusions and policy statements**, will be **published as an edited book**, serving as a lasting scholarly and policy resource arising from the Global S a T A Conference.
